It is the role of the CSP rep to:

- Provide a written or oral report to parents at school meetings and ensures CSP communications (i.e. parent Forum flyers) reaches parents.
- Informs the CSP about parent concerns and issues.
- Keeps in contact with the school Principal and/or Parish Priest.
- Attends CSP cluster meetings once a term
- Attends annual CSP leadership evening, P & F Workshops and Parent Seminars.
