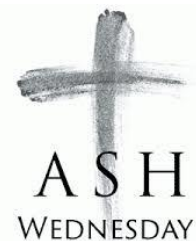
### P&F Wine and Cheese (and AGM)

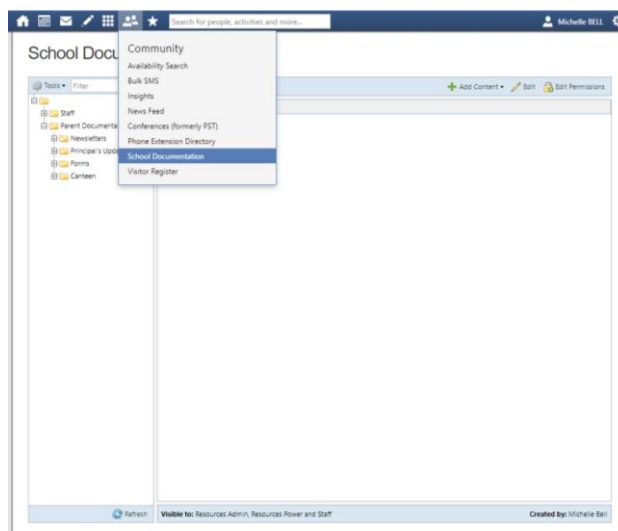
## News from School Office:

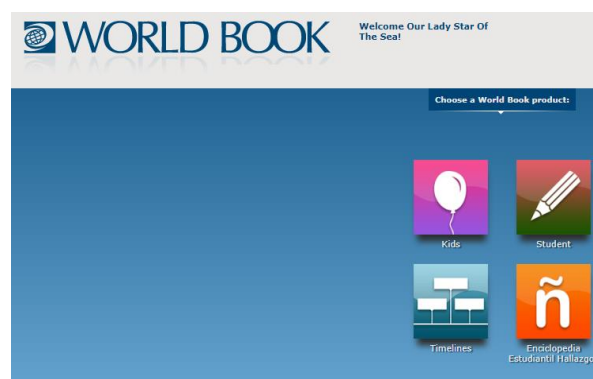
