Uniform Policy

Uniform Policy Preamble

At Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Primary School, we believe our school uniform and the presentation of our students, reflects very much the way in which we wish to be viewed by our school and parish community, as well as the wider community in which we live.

So why do we believe wearing a uniform correctly and presenting ourselves in a particular way is so important?

- It gives students a sense of belonging and enhances pride in their school. Wearing a uniform shows we are together, and we work together. In much the same way sport followers will wear their team's jersey or scarf, a uniform builds that sense of community.
- It helps students prepare for the workforce. Even at a young age, whether it's wearing safety gear in a construction job or corporate wear in an office, most jobs require a standard of dress. This is a great lead into what they might expect out in the real world.
- Uniforms actually cost less than a normal wardrobe. It may seem that some individual uniform items are expensive but when compared to having a whole wardrobe of different outfits, the overall price is much smaller.
- Uniforms and presenting ourselves correctly reduces peer pressure and bullying. Our students come from a wide range of family situations. Some are wealthy and others struggle. Students cannot be judged by their appearance because they are all wearing the same uniforms, no one has more expensive jewellery or watches than someone else, our hairstyles do not separate us from each other or single us out as better or more trendy.

Implementation: All students are asked to always wear the correct and complete uniform; including hair, jewellery, and accessories.

Ensuring a uniform is worn correctly and ensuring students present themselves in a certain manner is not about stifling individuality. Students have plenty of time to exercise their individuality outside of school as much as they wish. We put these expectations in place to build community, to set standards and to ensure we promote a school based on pride in our appearance.

Students are expected to keep their hair well-groomed. Hair below the collar is to always be tied up. Extreme styles are not acceptable. Examples of unacceptable styles include what are known as 'undercuts', 'layers', 'steps', 'lines' and 'burst fades', mullets and rat's tails. This list is not exhaustive.

Ultimately, the School Executive will determine if a cut is acceptable for the appropriate image that OLSS wishes to present to the community.

BOYS WINTER UNIFORM:

PANTS: Shorts as for summer or classic navy long trousers with logo SHIRT: Long sleeve blue shirt with school emblem on the collar SOCKS: Navy blue crew length SHOES: Black leather school (All leather Asics shoes are acceptable) JUMPER: Woollen jumper with school logo HAT: Navy blue with school logo

GIRLS SPORTS UNIFORM:

SHIRT: Light blue polo shirt with piping and school logo
SHORTS: Navy blue (unisex) or long pants with piping and school logo
SOCKS: White crew length (with white shoes) or navy socks (with black shoes)
SHOES: White or black sports shoes not coloured
JACKET: Navy zip jacket with piping and school logo
Broken Bay sport merchandise is <u>not</u> part of OLSS school uniform
